Local Students Receive Discovery Scholarships from Koch Petroleum Group

Twenty-two students awarded \$2000 each for academic/volunteer efforts

Rosemount, Minn.— Twenty-two high school seniors from eleven Dakota County & South Washington County schools received a total of \$44,000 in Pine Bend Discovery Scholarships from Koch Petroleum Group, L.P. The students will be recognized at a special awards banquet on June 12.
