KOCH PIPELINE COMPANY EMPLOYEES REACH THE 5 MILLION WORK-HOUR SAFETY MILESTONE

Wichita, Kan. — Employees of Koch Pipeline Company, L.P. have set a company safety record by working 5 million hours without a lost-time incident. The milestone was reached March 12.

"This achievement represents years of hard work and commitment by everyone within Koch Pipeline. I am very proud to work with such a dedicated team of individuals that has accomplished so much," said Bob O'Hair, president. "This very significant milestone could not have been possible without everyone's personal commitment, involvement, contribution and ownership for safety."

Another safety record was set in 2006 when employees reached 1 million work hours without a U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration recordable incident.

The company, which operates about 4,000 miles of pipeline in the United States, received the 2006 Occupational Industry Leader Award from the National Safety Council for achieving the best performance (lowest total incidence rating) based on lost workday cases in its NAICS category in 2005. The company has also earned the pipeline industry's highest award, the Occupational Safety Performance Award from the American Petroleum Institute.
