FLINT HILLS RESOURCES DONATES \$30,000 FOR FIESTA DE LOS NINOS; 2003 HOSPITAL FUNDRAISER DETAILS ANNOUNCED

(Corpus Christi, TX) Driscoll Children's Hospital today announced a \$30,000 donation from Flint Hills Resources, LP to Fiesta de los Ninos, Driscoll's annual fundraiser. The 11th Annual Fiesta de los Ninos will be held on Friday, February 21, 2003 at the Bayfront Convention Center and feature legendary country singer, Jerry Jeff Walker.
