INVISTA Waynesboro Site Receives Corporate Wildlife Habitat Certification

INVISTA Provides Bluebird Nest Monitoring Program

WAYNESBORO, **Va.** – January 12, 2005 – INVISTA has received the Corporate Wildlife Habitat Certification/International Accreditation Program Certificate from the Wildlife Habitat Council (WHC). This certification was given to INVISTA for having property established and meeting the guidelines for a corporate habitat enhancement area.

Brenda Kennell, INVISTA's environmental specialist and site coordinator for the Wildlife Habitat Enhancement Program, accepted the award on behalf of the company on November 16, 2004 at the WHC Symposium Banquet in Baltimore, Maryland. This certification runs through August 2006.

The INVISTA Waynesboro Baugher Farm (for which the certification was received) is a 100-acre site, with 95 acres of grassland and woodland habitat dedicated to wildlife. In addition, a successful eastern bluebird nest monitoring program has been in place since 1993.

"In this habitat, we provide and monitor 10 blue bird boxes to supply housing for them and encourage nesting," said Kennell. "Employees, retirees and community members monitor these boxes in the spring and summer, counting the number of young who fledge and removing the nests after the birds have left so that new inhabitants can build new nests."
