REFINERY EMPLOYEES NOTCH ANOTHER SAFETY MILESTONE

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas— Flint Hills Resources employees at the company's Corpus Christi refining complex completed one year without a recordable injury on Feb. 24.

"This is an amazing accomplishment, considering the amount of work our team has completed in the past year," said Dave Allen, vice president of manufacturing and refinery manager. "In 2006, we faced the most extensive maintenance project ever undertaken at our facility. This outstanding performance, while faced with the additional challenges presented by this turnaround, demonstrates each employee's commitment to working safely and focusing on safety basics. We all are very proud to sustain such performance."

Both refineries in the complex are U.S. Occupational Safety & Health Administration Voluntary Protection Program Star sites. The complex employs about 900 people.

Flint Hills Resources, which celebrated 25 years as a Coastal Bend corporate citizen in 2006, recently announced the \$761 million acquisition of base chemicals and polymers assets from Huntsman Corp. Following the third quarter close of that deal, FHR expects to add several hundred new employees in Texas, as well as employees in Illinois, Michigan and Kansas.
